**RESOLUTION R-21-02**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP of COLLEGE, CENTRE COUNTY,  
PENNSYLVANIA EXTENDING THE EXPIRATION DATE OF ORDINANCE  
#O-20-08 - THE TEMPORARY EMERGENCY ENFORCEMENT OF  
WEARING OF FACE COVERINGS, MAXIMUM GATHERING SIZE, LINE  
WAITING AND HOSTING OF EVENTS**

**WHEREAS**, on March 6, 2020, the Governor of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, pursuant to the provisions of Subsection 7301(c) of the Emergency Management Services Code, 35 Pa. C.S. § 7101, et seq., proclaimed the existence of a disaster emergency throughout the Commonwealth in response to a novel coronavirus (now known as “COVID-19”); and,

**WHEREAS**, the General Forum of the Centre Region Council of Governments, Centre County, Pennsylvania approved a Disaster Declaration on March 16, 2020; and,

**WHEREAS**, both the aforementioned Pennsylvania Disaster Emergency and the Centre Region Disaster Declaration remain in effect; and,

**WHEREAS**, on September 29, 2020, the Council of the Township of College, Centre County, Pennsylvania, approved Ordinance #O-20-08, enacting temporary emergency enforcement of the wearing of face coverings, maximum gathering size, line waiting and hosting of events; and Resolution #R-20-23 establishing the effective and expiration dates of Ordinance #O-20-08,

**WHEREAS**, as of Wednesday, December 30, 2020, there continues to be substantial community transmission of the COVID-19 virus within Centre County, Pennsylvania, with eight thousand, nine hundred and eight-four (8,984), confirmed and/or presumed positive cases of COVID-19 identified from the start of the pandemic to date; and,

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,**

That the Council of the Township of College, Centre County, Pennsylvania does hereby extend the expiration date of Ordinance #O-20-08, thus extending the temporary emergency enforcement of the wearing of face coverings, maximum gathering size, line waiting and hosting of events, from ***11:59 pm on Monday, January 4, 2021*** to ***12:01 am on Friday, April 2, 2021***, unless otherwise repealed, rescinded or extended via resolution in response to the evolving aspects of the COVID-19 public health emergency.
