RESOLUTION R-21-11

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF COLLEGE, CENTRE
COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, ESTABLISHING FEES AND PENALTIES IN
RELATION TO THE KEEPING OF CHICKENS IN RESIDENTIAL
AREAS ORDINANCE**

WHEREAS the Township of College, Centre County, Pennsylvania having conducted a public hearing and having duly adopted Ordinance O-21-02, Keeping of Chickens in Residential Areas, on the 18th day of February, 2021; and

THIS RESOLUTION is made this 4th day of March, by the College Township Council to add the following renewable license fee to Appendix Chapter A203, Fees and Penalties, as follows:

ADD the following to College Township Ordinance 100, Appendix Chapter A203,

§ A203-25 – Keeping of Backyard Chickens

Pursuant to Chapter 200-11 Use Regulations, Section A. Accessory Uses, (11) The Keeping of Backyard Chickens, (j) Applications for Permits and License, the following fees and penalties are hereby established.

A. Zoning permit fee.

(1) The fee shall be \$30.

B. License fees for Keeping of Backyard Chickens

(1) The renewable license fee of \$30, shall be valid for three (3) years, after which the license may be renewed upon payment of fee and compliance with §200-11A (11) The Keeping of Backyard Chickens.
